



Powerful questions/statements

A good question or statement is a simple hook to stimulate a discussion. It should spark imagination and open avenues of discussion so the participants can explore and create a connection with the topic on a personal level. A good question should be:

Personal – What are your students interested in, and how can you link it to the topic?

Current – Is the topic in the news or on TV? Are your students familiar with it?

Provocative – Is the subject something that your students could have a strong feeling about?
